Are quartz countertops really more expensive than granite? The answer is they would be about the same price. It would greatly depend on the quality of quartz being used. Quartz countertops are 97% quartz and a 3% resin. There are some companies that have a lower quartz count which would make the countertop less expensive but think quality when you go to purchase a countertop.

The last thing I want to leave you with is durability and quality. Quartz countertops never have to be sealed or maintained in its live time. Once the tops are installed they are yours to enjoy for a lifetime.
